ORDINANCE # 314 OF 2013

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, BOROUGH OF NORTH APOLLO, RELATED TO GOVERNING SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT IN AND THROUGH THE BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, Chapter 20 Part 1 of the North Apollo code of ordinances of the Borough of North Apollo governs solid waste management in the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance has not been amended since its passage in 1992; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions have arisen in the Borough of North Apollo requiring Council to revisit the ordinance and address specific matters for purposes of public safety;

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the Council of the Borough of North Apollo hereby now ordains and enacts the following amendments:

SECTION 102 DEFINITIONS

“LEAF WASTE” shall be amended to remove the provision “but not including grass clippings.” The definition shall hence forth be as follows:

- Leaves, garden residues, shrubbery, tree trimmings, and similar material, grass clippings, garden mulch, dead plants or tree branches.

“SOLID WASTE” is hereby amended as follows: waste including but not limited to municipal, residual or hazardous wastes, including solid, liquid, semisolid, or gaseous material, leaf waste and any other type of waste having a solid or semisolid form.

SECTION 103 PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

Section 103 of Chapter 20 Part 1 of the Code of Ordinances of North Apollo Borough is hereby amended to add the following provision.


Number 11. It shall be unlawful for any person, property owner, tenant, or resident in the Borough of North Apollo to allow or cause any leaf waste to be removed from personal property and blown into Borough roads, streets, alleys, sidewalks, sanitary or storm sewers, or any other Borough property including any bodies of water.

EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption hereof.




