ORDINANCE NO. 300 OF 2012

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTH APOLLO, COUNTY OF ARMSTRONG AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 283-2003 PROHIBITING THE CONNECTION OF STORM WATER DRAINS TO SANITARY SEWER LINES, REQUIRING PROPERTY OWNERS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF NORTH APOLLO TO DIRECT ALL SURFACE WATERS FROM BUILDING AND PREMISES TO BOROUGH STORM SEWERS AND PROVISIONS FOR NOTICE OF PROPERTY OWNERS AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCE.

Chapter XVII of the North Apollo Borough Ordinance governing sewer and sewage disposal, and Ordinance 283-2003 is amended as follows:

1. Section 2 shall be amended to include the following:

"Property owners are required to connect all drains located under roofs, including but not limited to those drains found in basements and garages, to the sanitary sewer system at a place designated by the Borough and where the lateral is provided, with the exception of the following which shall be connected to the storm water sewer system: foundation drains, yard drains, and any other drain designed for the purpose of or capable of collecting clean storm water. The connection of building drains to the lateral shall be made secure and water-tight. Upon completion of the sanitary sewer system connection, cesspools, sinkholes, septic tanks or similar waste receptacles shall be abandoned."
